VACANCY CIRCULAR

Indian Red Cross Society (IRCS) was established under the Parliament Act XV of 1920. It is the largest statutory humanitarian organization that works as Auxiliary to the Government and Armed Forces Medical services. It contributes to saving lives and protecting livelihood, providing relief in times of disaster and other emergencies.

2. IRCS adopts its rules and allowances with the approval of the Managing Body. The pay scales mentioned against each posts are approved by the Managing Body for its employees. The Other allowances as applicable as approved by the Managing Body from time to time. IRCS employees are not Government Employees, they are governed by the Rules adopted by its Managing Body.
