Our Impact

To safeguard the health workers on the frontline, **IRCS Goa** has donated 700 PPE Kits to the local Health Dept. The State Branch is also tirelessly disseminating accurate safety information among the masses. 8500 masks, 500 face guards & pair of gloves have been distributed till date

To spread awareness on covid19, **IRCS Uttarakhand** is visiting farmers & women engaged in agricultural activities during this harvest season. Social Distancing is also being promoted while working in the fields. The State has distributed 30,000+ masks & 4000 pair of gloves till date

By reaching the most vulnerable sections with food supply & other essential commodities, the **IRCS** team in **Andaman & Nicobar Islands** is ensuring that no one goes hungry. Till date, 3000+ cooked food packets & around 1000 dry ration kits have been distributed by the Branch
